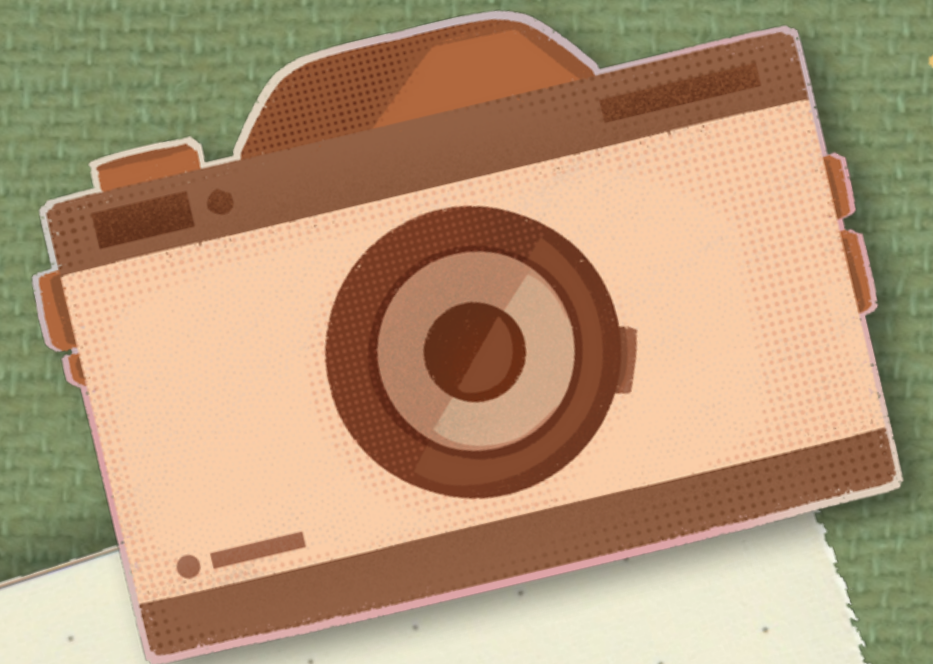

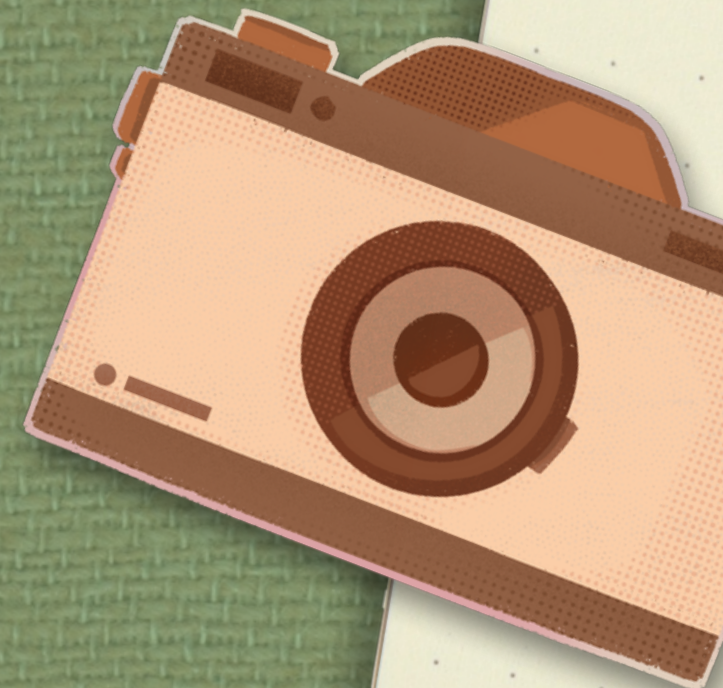
Shein and microplastics





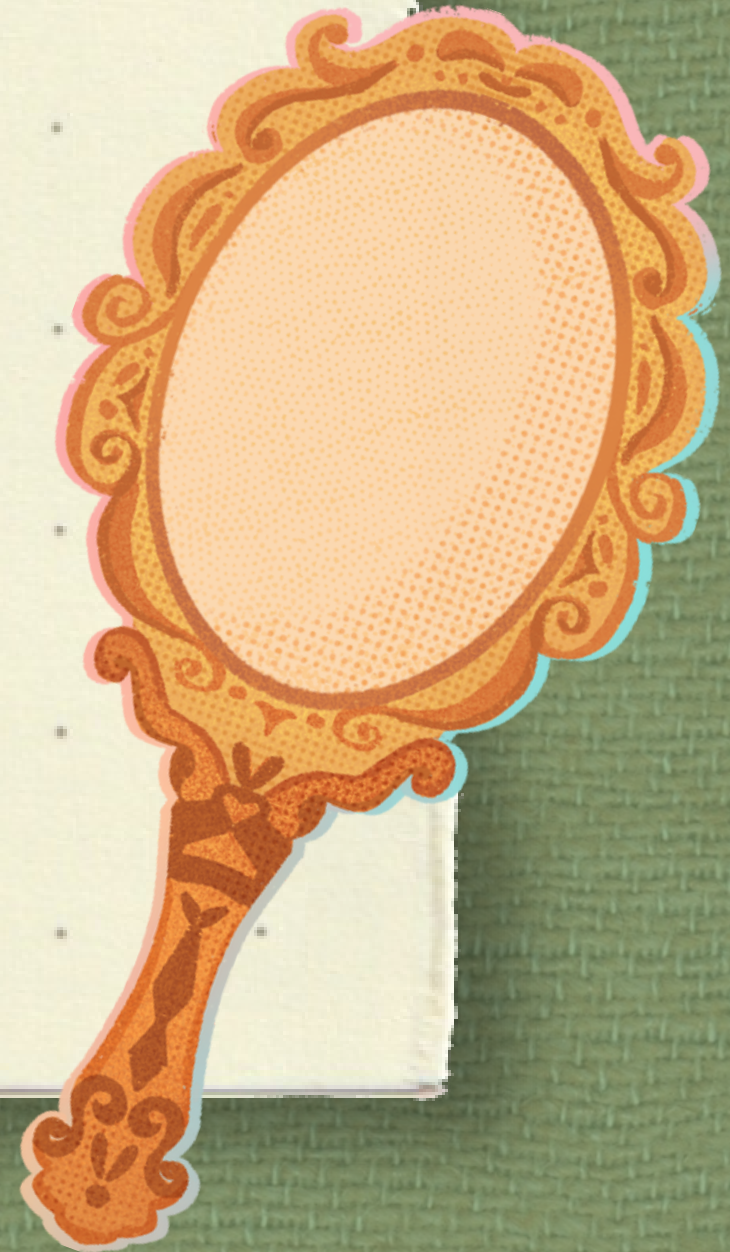
INTRO

An investigation by CBC Marketplace revealed that some Shein products contain lead, PFAS and phthalates. One children's jacket tested contained nearly 20 times the amount of lead considered safe by Health Canada. Greenpeace has also reported that some chemicals used in the product exceed EU legal limits. And the skin, in the prolonged contact with these substances, absorbs them.



Objectives
