PROBLEMS

- UNFAMILIAR TOPICS
- RELUCTANCY TO SPEAK IN PUBLIC
- GRAMMAR ACCURACY VS CONTENT



SOLUTIONS

- REASONABLE TIME TO FOCUS ON THE CONTENT
- GROUP/PAIR WORK
- INTELLIGIBILITY





DEVELOPING SKILLS: SPEAKING

THREE STAGES

- **PRESENTATION** teacher introduces new topic or something to be revised
- **PRACTICE** whole class and pair/group work activities to develop vocabulary and phonology
- **PRODUCTION** Pair work and group work activities to focus on content, develop communicative abilities, improve fluency.



DEVELOPING SKILLS: SPEAKING PRESENTATION ACTIVITIES

- Looking titles or visuals and predicting the content
- Asking questions/class discussion about the topic of a listening or reading text
- Eliciting background information about a specific topic
- Brainstorming words and expressions
- Reading aloud key sentences to improve pronunciation practice.

DEVELOPING SKILLS: SPEAKING PRACTICE ACTIVITIES

- Expanding sentences/Extending ideas
- Asking and answering questions
- Reading aloud key words/ sentences/paragraphs
- Guided oral summary



DEVELOPING SKILLS: SPEAKING PRODUCTION ACTIVITIES

- Interviews/Role plays
- Oral reports/presentation (also with the help of multimedia)
- Oral summary
