Sono state proposte le attività delle unità 1, 2, 3, 4, 5 del libro di testo Gold Experience B2, Pearson:

Unit 1 Wake up your senses!

Structures: present tenses review; comparative forms; adjectives and adverbs.

Topic: trying new things.

Skills and Functions: talking about things in or connected to the present; giving opinions and recommendation; writing a review.

Unit 2 On the bucket list.

Structures: past perfect simple and past perfect continuous; past perfect simple vs past perfect continuous; articles.

Topic: inspiration for travel.

Skills and Functions: talk about best and worst holidays experiences; describing, narrating and expressing contrast; writing an article.

Unit 3 All in a day's work

Structures: future forms review; determiners with countable and uncountable nouns.

Topic: virtual school.

Skills and Functions: understanding different speakers; justifying an opinion; writing an essay.

Unit 4 The heart of the city

Structures: conditionals; alternative conditional forms.

Topic: real or fake cities.

Skills and Functions: giving an opinion; giving the right information; writing an email.

Unit 5 A good spirit

Structures: infinitive and verbs +ing; verb patterns.

Topic: sport fans.
