Vocabulary: Crimes and criminals; types of evidence.

Structures: modals of speculation, obligation, prohibition, advice.

Skills and functions: saying what is necessary and isn't necessary; give possible

explanations for events in the past.

Competences: read and understand different texts; write an essay.

Unit 7 Frenemies

Vocabulary: relationships; reporting verbs.

Structures: If only/ I wish; reported speech review.

Skills and Functions: talk about wishes and regrets; report what people say.

Competences: read and understand different texts; write a description of your role model.

Unit 8 Look after yourself

Vocabulary: cooking methods and flavours; service verbs. **Structures**: modal passives; have/get something done.

Skills and Functions: use the passive form of modal verbs; talk about things you pay

someone else to do.

Competences: writing a report.

Unit 9 Future visions

Vocabulary: Life in space

Structures: futures review; future continuous and future perfect.

Skills and functions: talk about arrangements, schedules, plans and predictions; say if

actions will be in progress or completed in the future.

Competences: read and understand different texts; write an informal e-mail.
