Il manuale di grammatica, <u>Grammar 360°</u>, Oxford è stato utilizzato per un approfondimento delle strutture morfo-sintattiche e lessicali in vista delle verifiche scritte.

Unit 1 Identity

Structures: Present simple vs Present continuous. Past simple vs Past continuous. Ability in the present and in the past.

Vocabulary: personal description. Experiences. Stereotypes.

Skills and Functions: giving personal information; adding information; talking about identity; finding out about lifestyles; talking about past experiences.

Unit 2 The environment

Structures: used to. Subject vs object questions. Past perfect.

Vocabulary: Conservation. Natural Phenomena.

Skills and Functions: talking about the environment; expressing emotions; contrasting ideas; narrating events in a story; writing a story.

Unit 3 Social Circles

Structures: present perfect. Present perfect with *how long/for/since*. Present perfect continuous.

Vocabulary: relationships. Interacting.

Skills and Functions: talking about others; confirming and contradicting; writing a biography of a living person.

Unit 4 Too much stuff

Structures: verbs of perception. Present and past participles as adjectives. Adverbs of manner and degree.

Vocabulary: consumer products. Producer to consumer.

Skills and Functions: giving instructions; giving directions; distinguishing facts from opinions; writing an email of complaint.

Unit 5 Home life

Structures: uses of get. Should, ought to, had better, (don't) have to, (don't) need to, must(n't).

Vocabulary: housing. Housework.

Skills and Functions: giving and receiving advice.

Unit 6 Lifelong learning

Structures: defining relative clauses. Non-defining relative clauses. Question tags.

Vocabulary: Continuing education. Skills.

Skills and Functions: explaining reasons; maintaining interaction; writing an email of enquiry.
